

OSCOLA Ireland Quick Reference Guide

Primary Sources

Do not use full stops in abbreviations. Separate citations with a semi-colon. Close footnotes with a full stop.

Constitution

Article 40.3.3°.

Cases

Give the party names, followed by the neutral citation, followed by the *Irish Reports* citation. If there is no neutral citation, give the *Irish Reports* citation followed by the court in brackets. If the case is not reported in the *Irish Reports*, cite the *Irish Law Reports Monthly* if possible, or other reports otherwise:

Riordan v Ireland [2009] IESC 44, [2009] 3 IR 745.

Doran v Delaney [1998] 2 IR 61 (SC).

Friends of the Curragh Environment Ltd v An Bord Pleanála (No 2) [2006] IEHC 390, [2007] 1 ILRM 386.

When pinpointing, give paragraph numbers in square brackets with the name of the judge at the end of the citation. If the judgment has no paragraph numbers, but does have page numbers, give the page number after the court. If there are no paragraph numbers or page numbers, do not include a pinpoint reference.

Secondary Sources

Do not use superscript for dates and editions (2nd, not 2nd).

Books

Give the author's name in the same form as in the publication, except in bibliographies, where you should give only the surname followed by the initials(s). Give relevant information about editions, translators and such before the publisher. Put a comma after this information, but not between publisher and year. When pinpointing, give page numbers at the end of the citation, after the brackets.
